
JUDGMENT ORDER

The Court presided over a non-jury trial of this case on December 6 and 7, 2004. At the conclusion of the evidence, the Court made oral findings of fact and conclusions of law on the record on December 7, 2004. *See* Super. Ct. Civ. R. 52(a). Consistent with those findings of fact and conclusions of law, it is this 8 day of December 2004

ORDERED that the plaintiff shall recover \$94,500.00 from defendant Fax.com, Inc. and \$85,500.00 from defendants Kevin Katz and Eric Wilson, plus interest at the statutory rate from December 7, 2004 and her costs of action. The defendants' liability shall be joint and several. It is further

ORDERED that the defendants are hereby permanently enjoined from taking any actions in or affecting persons in the District of Columbia, either personally or through third persons or entities, in violation of the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act, 47 U.S.C. § 227. It is further

ORDERED that this is intended as a final judgment. *See* Super. Ct. Civ. R. 58.
